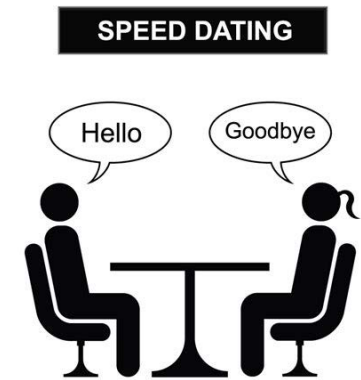

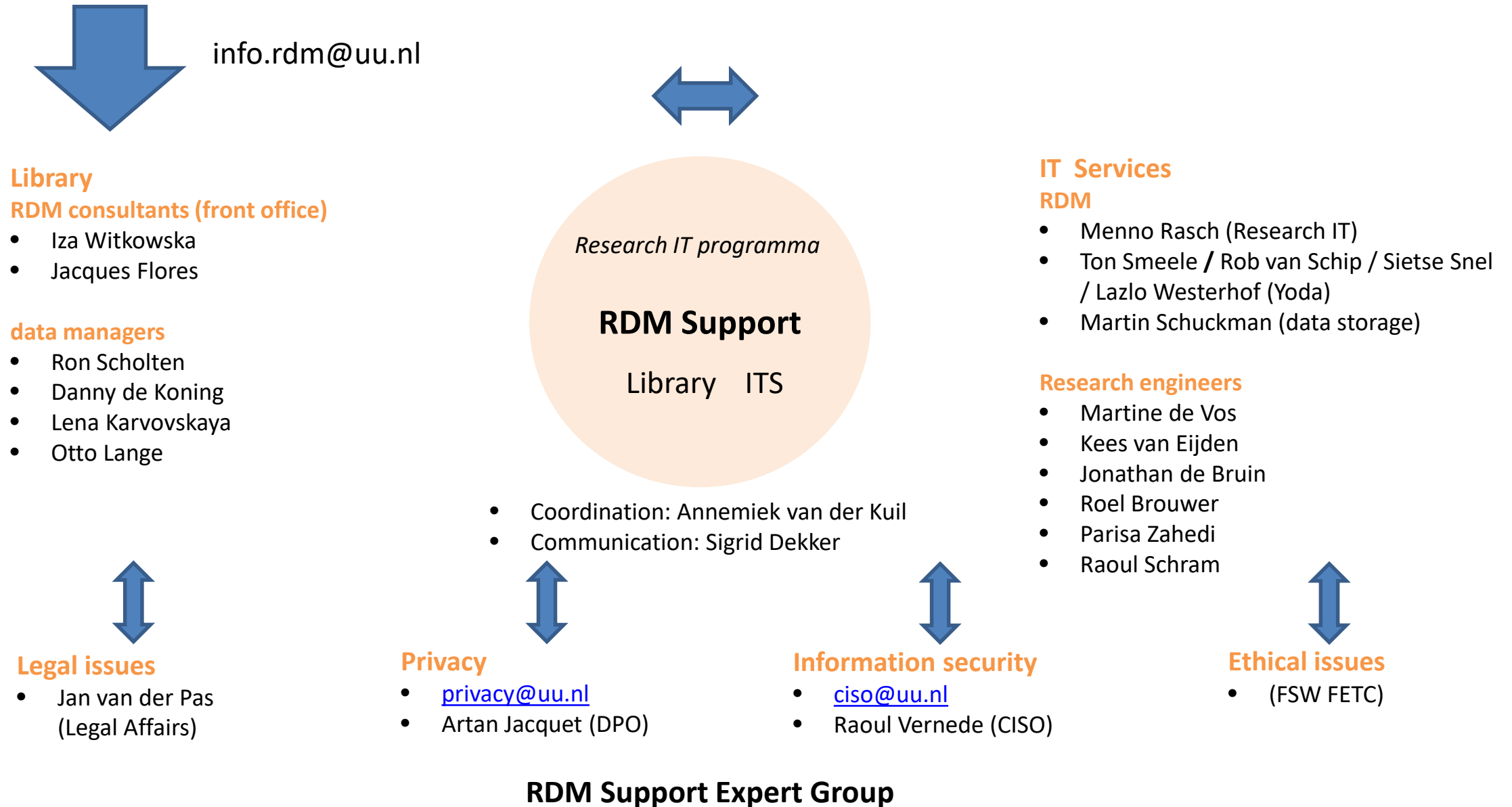


Different levels of our network

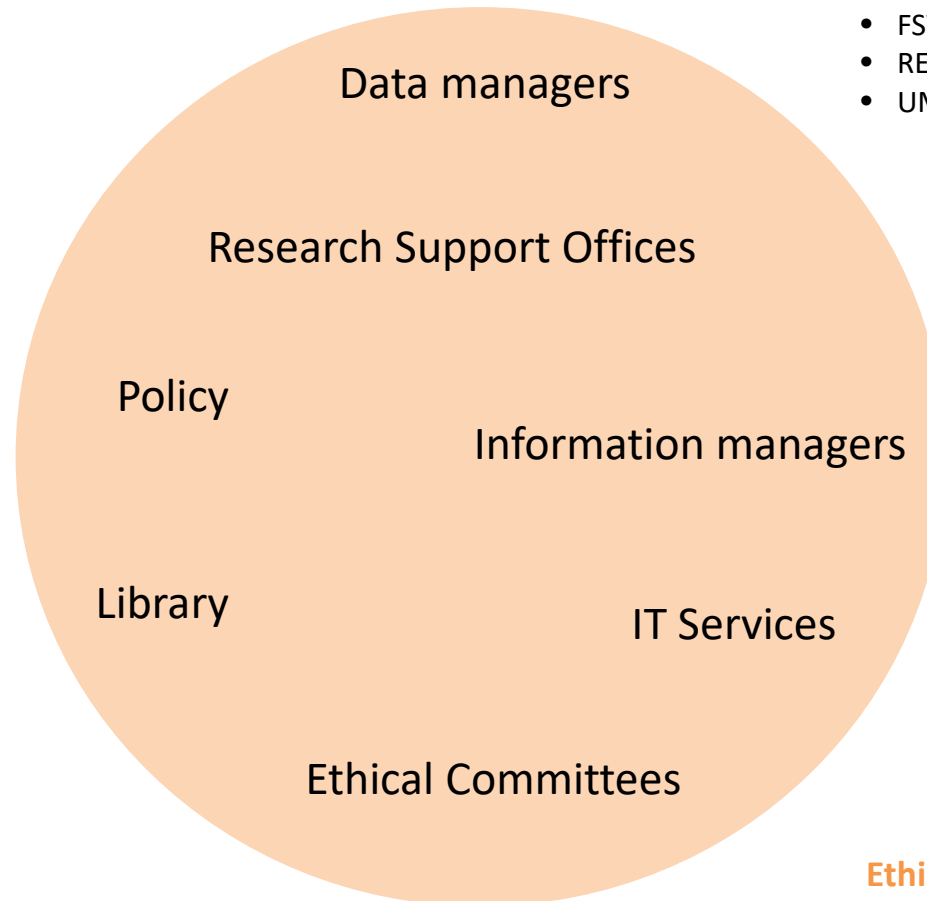

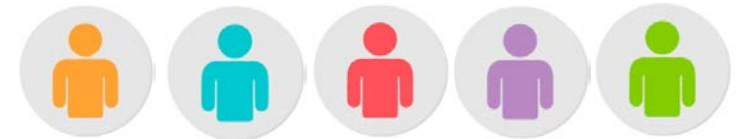
